What's a hazard?

A coal mine hazard is:

- the collapse of shallow coal mine workings
- the collapse of, or risks of entry to, coal shafts and tunnels
- gas emissions from former coal mines (including methane and carbon dioxide)
- spontaneous combustion of coal, which may lead to underground heatings/fires and production of carbon monoxide
- transmission of gases to adjacent properties through underground pathways
- water emissions from former coal mine workings
